Action

- 1 **Welcome & apologies**
- 1.1 Apologies were received from Councillors' Glyn Caron, Kathy Evans, Chris Tew, Colette Thomas and Raymond Williams.
- 2 **Declarations of interest**
- 2.1 The CLO reminded Members that if they felt that they had an interest to declare in any items, they should do so and record it on the Declarations of Interest pro forma provided.
- 2.2 The CLO left the meeting.
- 3 **Minutes 9.5.2018**
- 3.1 The minutes of the meeting held on 9th May 2018 were confirmed as an accurate record.

4 **Action sheet**

- 4.1 The CSO confirmed that email updates had been sent to the Committee regarding all of the actions listed within the action sheet.
- 4.2 In terms of the first action, regarding the Self Evaluation Report (SER), the COE explained that the action may alter in due course, as Estyn were no longer expecting a stand-alone document. Instead, Estyn wanted to see how the Local Education Authority (LEA) was keeping members up to speed in terms of LEA plans and how the LEA reviewed all of its work on a continuous basis.
- 4.3 The committee noted the action sheet.

5 **Update Report - Progress Against Adopted Action Plans**

- 5.1 The Chair and the CSO introduced the report, provided a brief background and confirmed the suggested scrutiny activity.
- 5.2 The relevant officers provided updates and answers to members' questions regarding the topics below.
- 5.3 Estyn Report – Improving Schools Through Regional Education Consortia
The COE confirmed that an update to the national model for regional school improvement services would be available soon; however he was not anticipating any significant changes in respect of the region.
- 5.4 The Committee agreed to retain this item for further updates.
- 5.5 WAO Report – Achieving Improvement in Support to Schools Through Regional Education Consortia – An Early View
The COE suggested that the Committee would want to consider the Education Achievement Service (EAS) Business Plan as a scrutiny item during the following year. He explained that the LEA and their partners, who were commissioning owners of the EAS, wanted to see significant progress in terms of embedding the self-improvement system in the region. He added that the EAS was in a really strong position to achieve this.
- 5.6 The Committee agreed to retain this item for further updates.
- 5.7 Estyn Inspection of October 2011 & 2013 Estyn Monitoring Visit
The COE assured the Committee that the LEA were constantly mindful of their previous position but were always looking to the future.
- 5.8 The Committee agreed to remove this item from future monitoring reports.
- 5.9 Cllr Seabourne suggested that it would be useful to receive feedback regarding the reconstituted Children & Young People's Improvement Board (CYPIB).

5.10 WAO Review – Young People Not in Education, Employment or Training (Local Feedback)

The COE confirmed that the CYPIB would be reconstituted and that a paper had been presented to the Chair of the Public Services Board (PSB) around how the CYPIB would fit into the PSB's Wellbeing Plan.

5.11 The COE confirmed that the Pupil Progress Group was also being reconstituted, which had previously co-ordinated successful work around Young People Not in Education, Employment or Training (NEET). Further updates regarding this significant piece of work would follow in due course.

5.12 The HoS&E confirmed that NEET numbers had dropped considerably and that procedures and processes were imbedded. The LEA measure, at Year 11, stood at a very low 1.1% and it would probably stay around that mark.

5.13 The Committee agreed to retain this item for further updates.

6 **Schools Standards Monitoring Sub Committee Membership**

6.1 The Corporate Scrutiny Officer (CSO) outlined the role of the Schools Standards Monitoring Sub-Committee and the proposed membership, seen within the report.

6.2 The CSO explained that membership of the sub-committee would be reviewed on an annual basis.

6.3 **The committee agreed:**

- i. **The membership of the School's Standards Monitoring Sub-Committee for 2018-19, as per the report (in accordance with the relevant political balance calculations);**
- ii. **The sub-committee should continue to focus specifically on individual schools performance and the support they receive.**

7 **Date of next meeting**

7.1 The Chair confirmed that the date of the next meeting would be circulated as soon as possible.
