#### **Support for Torfaen's Most Vulnerable Residents**

**Recommendation 1:-** Provide a clearer explanation regarding the % of looked after children returned home from care, differentiating those returned to parents but still under local authority care.

**Recommendation 2:-** Ensure the column "2020 CP3 targets" is completed for all improvement objectives.

#### **A Clean and Green Torfaen**

**Recommendation 3:-** Investigate whether drone technology could be used as a deterrent against fly-tipping in Torfaen.

**Recommendation 4:-** Widen the use of technology to improve how issues of cleanliness are reported directly to teams and ensuring where a technological solution is employed it is reliable and easy to use.

**Recommendation 5:-** Although members were largely satisfied with the progress made in the actions and measures, relating to cleanliness, in future the committee believe we should:

- Look to improve how we co-ordinate streetscene / cleanliness operations with Bron Afon to ensure they are effectively carried out to the satisfaction of all residents no matter where the issues are within the Borough (1.1),
- Continue to encourage more communities to get involved in the

- annual Spring Clean (1.2), and
- Develop a better understanding within communities of the work the Council does to maintain open spaces (1.3)

### **Raising Educational Attainment**

**Recommendation 6:-** Review whether the language used for performance measures could be made less technical in future and therefore easier to read for members of the public.

**Recommendation 7:-** In future years, consideration should be given to the inclusion of measures for attendance and exclusions (as these are important contributors to attainment), to help support progression of the corporate plan.

**Recommendation 8:-** A piece of work to be undertaken by Education to identify key measures for reporting performance to scrutiny, that can be effectively benchmarked against others and demonstrate progress year on year.

**Recommendation 9:-** Carry out an investigation as to whether teacher assessments are being carried out consistently across schools in Torfaen.

### **Support for Torfaen's Most Vulnerable Residents**

**Recommendation 10:-** The local authority should continue to lobby Welsh Government with regards to the wording of performance measures to ensure they are outcome focussed, clear and understandable to all.

**Recommendation 11:-** Future plans and their updates should give greater emphasis on how we are working collaboratively and preventatively to:

1. Assess whether people are ready to be discharged from hospital.
2. Develop services for young people and their families.

Whilst the committee felt able to support all activities, measures and targets as set out within the report, individual workshop tables also agreed to making the following comments for consideration by cabinet, corporate plan sponsors and individual scrutiny committees:

### **Green and Clean**

1. Happy with progress made regarding recycling participation rates, however due to changes in the definition of the recycling/composting measure, members were keen to investigate further (**through the Cleaner O&S Committee in January**), how can we ensure we are able to meet future targets and avoid fines.
2. The Council should look to communicate with residents their responsibilities regarding fly-tipping and highlight the impact it has on the environment and the council's budget.
